First Nations Scholarship Information

CanScribe's education scholarships offer opportunity to people who have focused education and career goals, but are facing financial or situational challenges.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the scholarship, a recipient must:

- Qualify to enroll in the Medical Transcription program by completing a program application form online
- Submit their essay to admissions@canscribe.com no later than April 30th of that year
- Pay the remaining tuition balance immediately, not combinable with any other scholarships or funding
- Start the program within 3 months of the award date
- Start the program **after** receiving the scholarship (current students are not eligible)

Please note that if any of the above points are not met, the applicant will not be eligible for the scholarship award, and another recipient will be chosen.

To help us evaluate your application, please include the following documents:

- Canadian First Nations Status Card
- A 1–2-page personal essay describing your personal motivation for applying for the scholarship, your background information, how this career choice will impact your life, your plan of action to complete the course, and your future goals and aspirations.
